

Plastic-Free Bottled Water

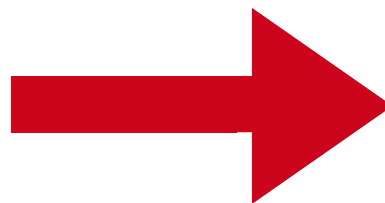
We prefer glass. It is 100% sustainable, inert and will not cause damage to the marine environment if it escapes into our oceans.

International Waters

San Pellegrino

One of the top recognised bottled waters. However, often the 250 ml and 500 ml sizes are either bottled in plastic bottles or have the plastic sealing ring. Please ensure the water option you order is glass with a bottle cap like those seen here.



Acqua Panna

Imported from Italy. We have observed bottles in the 500ml range that have bottle cap lids but this is not always the case. Make sure you ask when ordering bottles from your distributor.



Perrier

Imported from France. These come in a range of sparkling, lemon and lime. All lids we have seen are suitable, making this recognised mineral water brand an easy option.



NOT SUITABLE

San Benedetto

Imported from Italy. Due to the plastic rings on all the bottles we have seen, we can't recommend any of them as suitable. There may be a bottle option we are not aware of and we will continue to investigate.



NOT SUITABLE

VOSS

One of the most successful bottled water brands due to their attractive bottle. We don't recommend this water simply because the plastic lid isn't recycled on the Sunshine Coast (plastic must be bigger than a small yoghurt container to be captured in recycling).

An Australian company that does flavoured water. There is a simple sparkling water option in the range but also several flavours if you want to stock some variety.
